GUIDANCE

POINT: John Steinbeck makes extensive use of the technique of *foreshadowing*...

EXAMPLE: The character ... confides in George after his dog was put down that he...

EXPLANATION: This event foreshadows...

"Quote Weaving"

A technique whereby an author embeds a quotation into their analysis as if it were part of the sentences they are writing.
